### How to get to Barclay Viewforth Church

#### On Foot:

Barclay Viewforth Church is situated 100 metres south of the King's Theatre and can be accessed from 3 streets: Bruntsfield Place; Glengyle Terrace and Wright's Houses. The Church Centre is accessed from Wright's Houses, opposite the Bruntsfield Links (lower section)

#### Low Mobility access:

The Church and the Church Centre can be accessed from the Wright's Houses side of the building for people in wheelchairs or with low mobility.

#### Bus routes:

Bus nos 11; 15; 16; 23; 45 all stop (in both directions) on the main road, Bruntsfield Place.

#### Car:

Street parking on Saturday is metered after 8.30am
